Do I have to take out a loan in order to request the Cleveland Restoration Society's assistance? No. We are happy to answer questions about improvements to or maintenance of your older home. Are there income restrictions? Some income guidelines may apply to take advantage of the low fixed rate. Contact our staff for the latest information. There are no income restrictions for our free technical consulting.

How can the Heritage Home Program offer such a low interest rate? CRS has partnered with City, County, and State governments and agencies to secure link-deposit funds that "buy down" traditional loan rates. As a result, loans are typically available at 3-4 % below market rate. Our successful combination of technical and financial incentives encourage homeowners to increase the value of their older homes by using a historic preservation approach.
